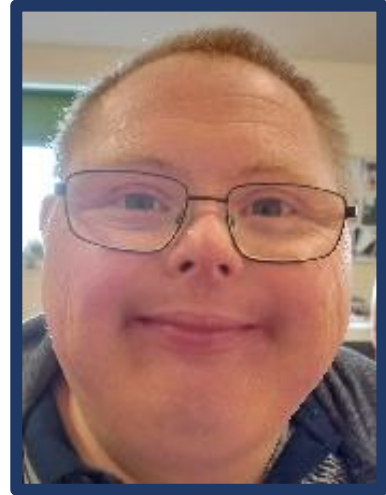




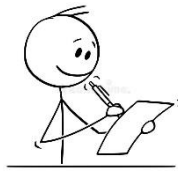
Meet
